The kindergarten teachers are looking forward to working with your child this September. We are providing a supply list to help you get ready for Kindergarten. We would appreciate if you could bring the following supplies during the first week of school.

- All students must have a book bag (The bag must fit books as big as the folders.)
- Lunch bag (This is only for students that bring lunch from home.)
- Small head phones (Headphones are for your child's personal use at the computer center. We prefer head phones to earbuds they fit better on small ears.)
- 2 Plastic 2-pocket folders (homework folders)
- 1-primary notebook (Spaces for drawing and writing)
- 1 box of crayons
- 2 black, big dry erase markers
- 1 pack of erasers
- 1 pack of #2 pencils (preferably beginner pencils with or without erasers)

Place folders, notebooks dry erase markers and erasers in a zip lock or bag with your child's name.

- 2 boxes of tissues
- A roll of paper towels
- 1 pack of baby wipes
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 pack of Clorox or Lysol wipes

Please label all of your child's possessions including sweaters, umbrellas, hats, coats and book bag to avoid any confusion.

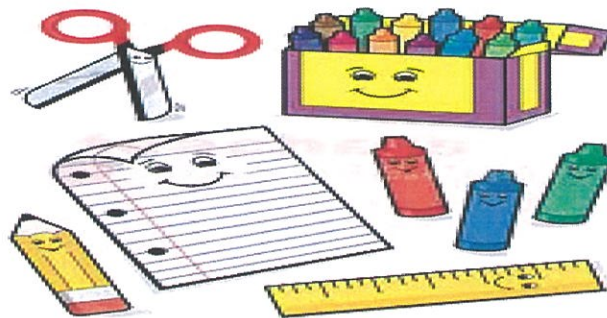

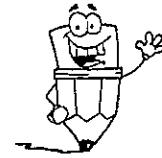

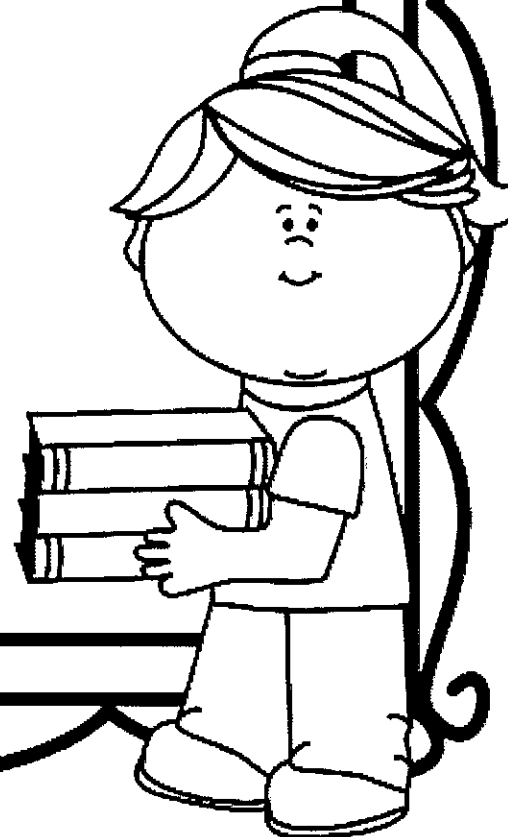
